

## **European Parliament**

### **Amendment to paragraph 1.1 of the COSAC CONTRIBUTION**

Replace the 3 last lines of the paragraph ("supports.... Union") by:  
"Welcomes the Commission's proposal on the new multi-annual financial framework for 2014-2020 and on the reform of the system of own resources".

### **Amendment to paragraph 1.3 of the COSAC CONTRIBUTION**

Delete the last sentence ("in certain cases.... global competitors") and replace it by:  
"the reform of the system of own resources should aim at more transparency for the citizens/tax payers".

### **Amendment to paragraph 1.4 of the COSAC CONTRIBUTION**

Read as follows: "Taking into account the complexity ... budgets, and in the light of the necessary complementarity between EU and National budgets, COSAC....."

### **Amendment to paragraph 1.5 of the COSAC CONTRIBUTION**

Replace "develop" by "negotiate"

### **Amendment to paragraph 2.8 of the COSAC CONTRIBUTION**

Add:

"COSAC notes furthermore that, for the European Parliament, the new provisions on delegated acts are one of the main achievements of the Treaty of Lisbon. Wherever the criteria of Article 290 are met, delegated acts must be included in all relevant European legislation in order to comply with the Treaty".

### **Amendment to paragraph 2.9 of the COSAC CONTRIBUTION**

Add at the end of the paragraph:

"and with the European Parliament".

### **Amendment to paragraph 3.1 of the CONCLUSIONS**

Read as follows:

"COSAC thanks the IPEX Board and in particular the European Parliament for the re-writing of the IPEX website and its launch on 28 June 2011 and welcomes the new technological facilities offered by the new platform".

### **Amendment to paragraph 3.2 of the CONCLUSIONS**

Read as follows:

"COSAC invites National Parliaments to timely publish ..... cooperation. COSAC encourages the National Parliaments to reconsider the role of IPEX correspondents in the light of the new tasks requested for the new website in order to ensure that IPEX becomes a more reliable source of information"
