#### ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES OF PARTICIPANTS

Participants are required to make their own travel arrangements from and to the airport. The Ruzyně Airport is situated 13 km west of the city centre. The journey by car from the airport to the centre of Prague may take 20-45 minutes depending on the traffic. The estimated airport taxi fare is 25 euros (one-way).

#### REGISTRATION

The participants registering for the meeting are requested to use the appropriate registration form.
