Dear Chairperson Cretu and Chairperson Tîlvăr,

On behalf of myself, and all of the Members of the Joint Committee on European Union Affairs of the Irish National Parliament, I would like to apologise that none of us are in a position to attend the meeting of the COSAC Chairperson being held in Bucharest on 20-21 January 2019.

As it happens, the COSAC Chairpersons meeting will coincide with the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the first meeting of Dáil Éireann (Ireland's equivalent to the Chamber of Deputies). It is an important historical event for Ireland, particularly for the National Parliament, and will be marked by a number of events including a Special Joint Sitting of both Houses of the Oireachtas on the 21st January.
