### **4. ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES OF PARTICIPANTS**

The Jože Pučnik Airport is situated 26 km north of the Ljubljana city centre. The journey by car from the Ljubljana airport to the centre of Ljubljana takes approximately half an hour.

The estimated airport taxi fare is 35 euros (one-way).

### **5. EXCURSIONS**

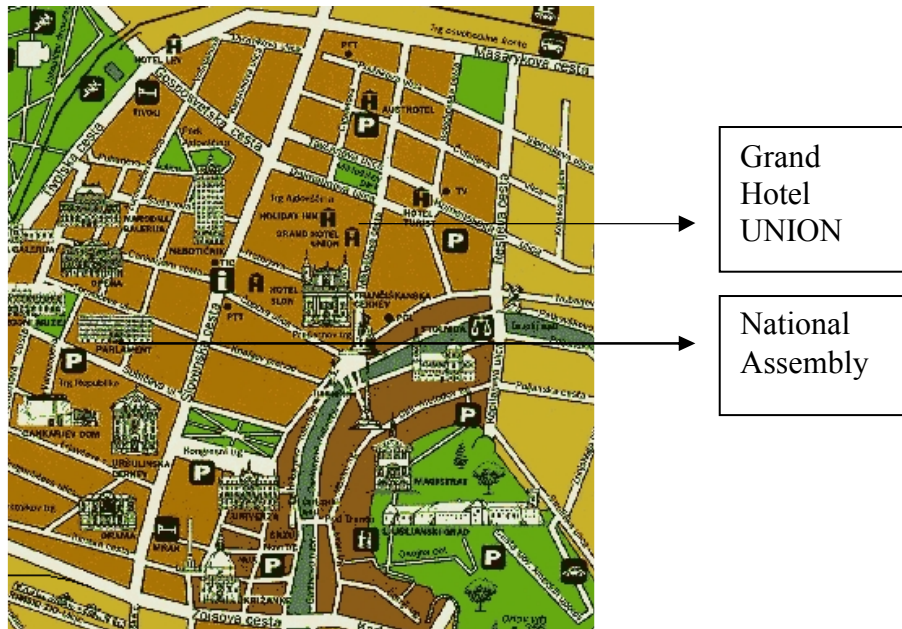
On Sunday, 17 February 2008, participants will be given a guided tour of the Postojna cave, situated 56 kilometres from Ljubljana. The departure from Ljubljana is scheduled at 14.45 and the journey to the site takes approximately 1 hour. The tour is planned to begin at 16.00 and will last an hour and a half. The departure from Postojna to Ljubljana is scheduled at 17.45. The cave has a constant temperature of 8°C, therefore comfortable shoes and warm clothes are recommended.

The participants not attending the excursion to the cave may join a guided tour of Ljubljana in English or French starting at 17.00 in front of the hotel.

### **6. TRANSPORT**

The Grand Hotel Union is located in the city centre, within 10 minutes walking distance from the National Assembly. Shuttle service will also be provided from the hotel to the National Assembly, particularly in the case of bad weather.
