



TROIKA MEETING TO BE HELD ON APRIL 5th 1993 IN COPENHAGEN

I am writing to invite you to the troika meeting which is to be held on April 5th 1993 at the Folketing leading up to the Eighth Conference of European Affairs Committees to be held on May 3rd - 4th 1993.

I suggest that we open the troika meeting at 10.00 a.m. and that we allow it to continue until 5.00 p.m., if necessary. Though in my opinion we do not need so many hours to draw up the agenda for the Eighth Conference.

It was agreed at the seventh meeting in London to reopen the discussion of some of the items in Copenhagen, and we should allow time to do so when drawing up the programme. What is more, we have arranged with the Danish Prime Minister and the Minister for Foreign Affairs to participate in the Conference on May 3rd but this is still subject to confirmation.

If you wish to make any proposals for the agenda, we would be grateful if you could let us have them by March 31st so that we can draw up a draft programme to be submitted at the opening of the meeting on April 5th 1993.

We should be happy to assist you in booking hotel rooms if you so require. Please let us know about this when you register for the troika meeting not later than March 12th 1993.
