The Finnish Presidency has implemented an online registration system for all meetings. Participants are kindly requested to register for the conference online by **3 November 2019**. Each national Parliament shall be represented by a maximum of six Members of its Committee(s) for Union Affairs. The European Parliament shall be represented by six Members. Each Parliament shall determine the composition of its own delegation. Three members of the Parliaments of each candidate country shall be invited as observers to plenary and extraordinary COSAC meetings. Two members of the Parliaments of each candidate country shall be invited as observers to the meetings of the Chairpersons of Committees for Union Affairs¹.

Transfers

Delegations are kindly requested to make their own arrangements for transportation from and to the airport.

Helsinki Airport is located about 21 km from the city centre, which is approximately a 40 minutes' drive depending on traffic. You can reach Helsinki by train, bus (https://www.hsl.fi/en), or taxi. Trains I and P go from the airport to Helsinki Central Station. From the Helsinki Central Station it is about 5 minutes' walk to the Radisson Blu Plaza. Tramline 4 goes from the Central Railway Station to Scandic Grand Marina and Hotel Katajanokka.

Finnair airport shuttle bus is working from the west side of the Helsinki Railway Station to the airport and back.

Time estimate for the journey is 40 minutes by bus and about 30–35 minutes by train or taxi. Note that the taxi services have been deregulated and as a result, the taximeters are no longer mandatory and the price of journey can vary. To facilitate the choice of a taxi at the airport, there are four lanes for taxis at the Helsinki Airport:

- The three lanes closest to the terminal exit are reserved for the taxi companies that won the competitive tendering (Lähitaksi, Vantaan Taksi and Taksi Helsinki).
- The fourth is for other taxi operators.
- Beside there is also an area for pre-reserved rides.
- Number for pre-reserving a taxi in Helsinki Airport (valid only in reservations from the airport): Taksi Helsinki +358 100 0600

The Finnish Parliament will provide transportation for the delegates to and from the conference and the dinner venues. Please note that the **buses for the airport leave at 14:30** after the meeting on Tuesday 3 December.

Please note that there will not be bus transportation from Scandic Grand Marina to the conference venue (the distance between the two is about 150 meters).

Interpretation

Simultaneous interpretation will be provided during the meeting in all the official languages of the European Union.

Power supply

230V electrical supply. Supply frequency is 50 Hz. Plug socket in use is the two-pinned Type F, "Schuko".

Tourism

Many sights in Helsinki can be easily reached on foot. For the attractions nearby the hotels and the Conference Venue, we recommend the Helsinki <u>Central Library Oodi</u>. It was built to celebrate Finland's 100-year independence, and it is architecturally an interesting, energy-efficient building. The art museum <u>Amos Rex</u>, opened in autumn 2018, is worth visiting for influential exhibitions. Buildings designed by one of the most notable architects in Finland, Alvar Aalto, can be found in the centre area. Excellent shopping facilities are located a short distance away from the hotels and the Conference Venue.
